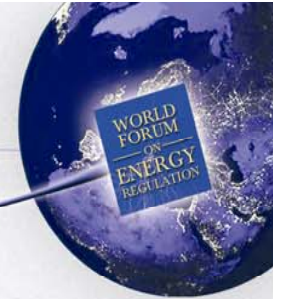

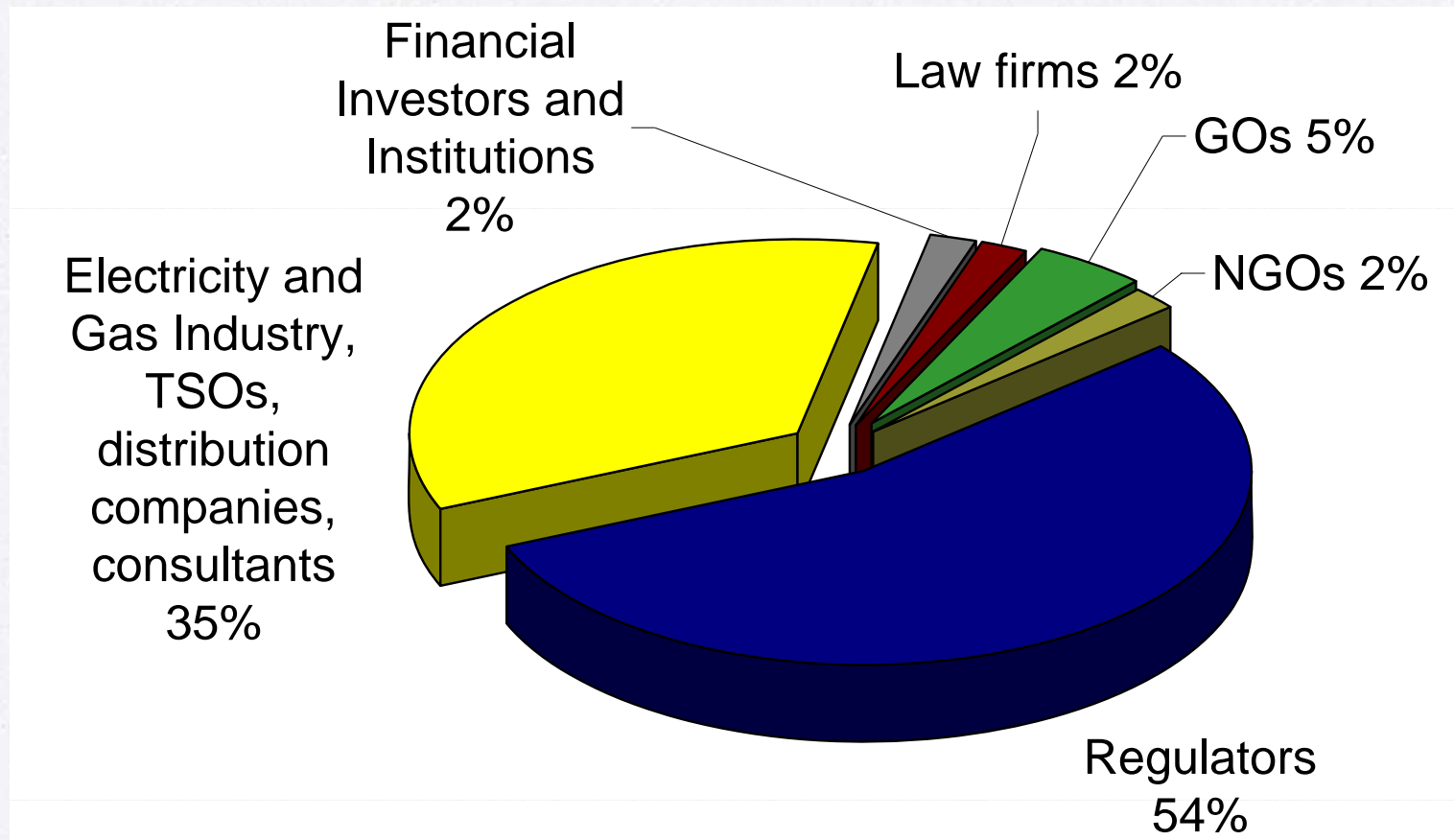
Participants breakdown by region (ca. 500 participants)



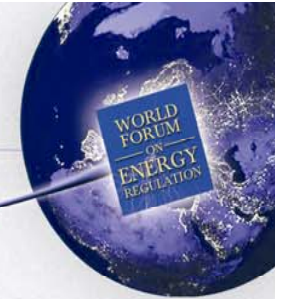

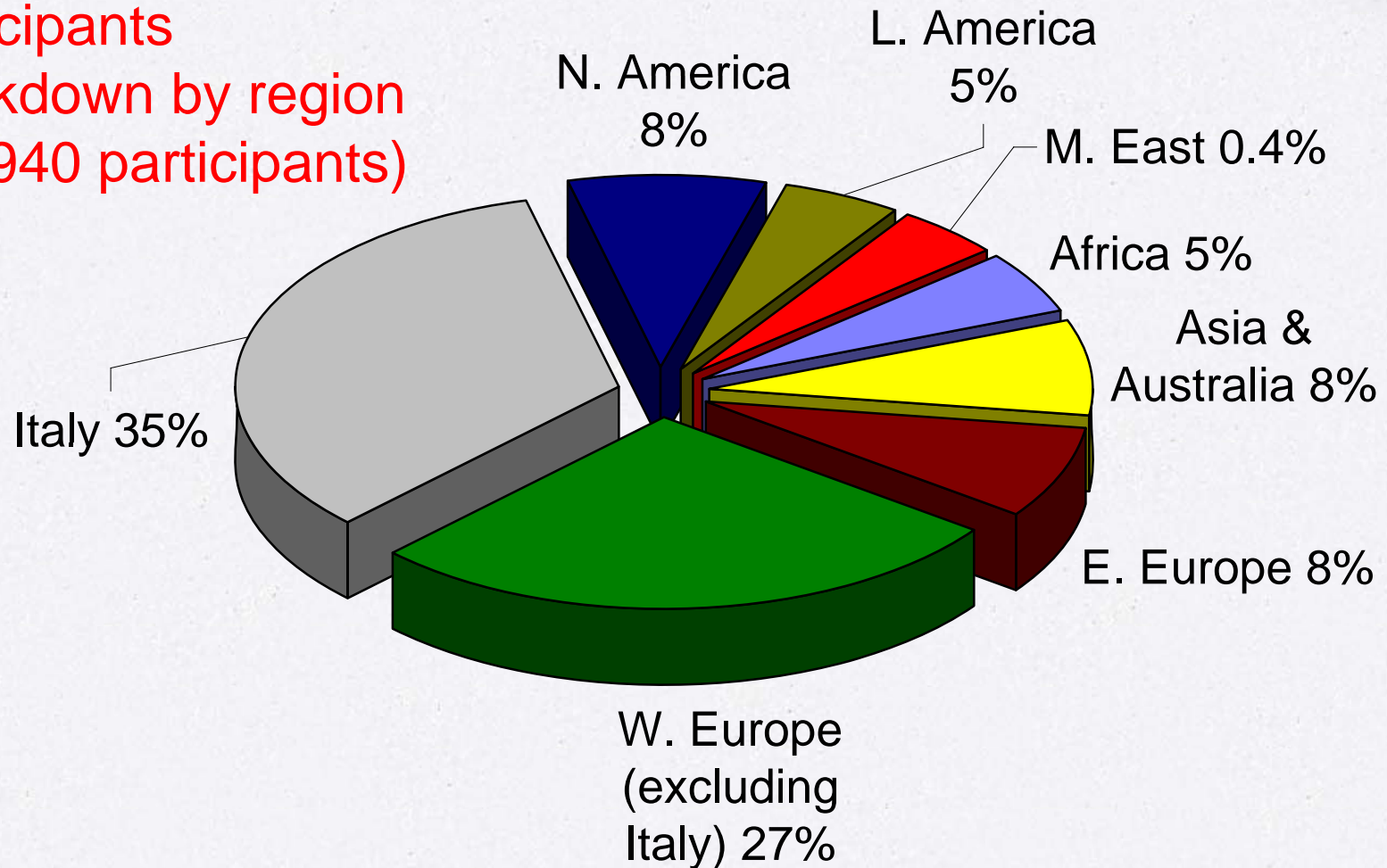
## Participants breakdown by sector



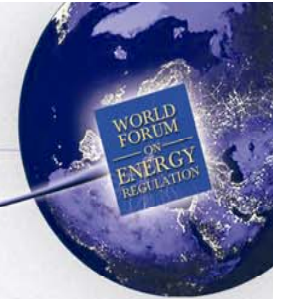

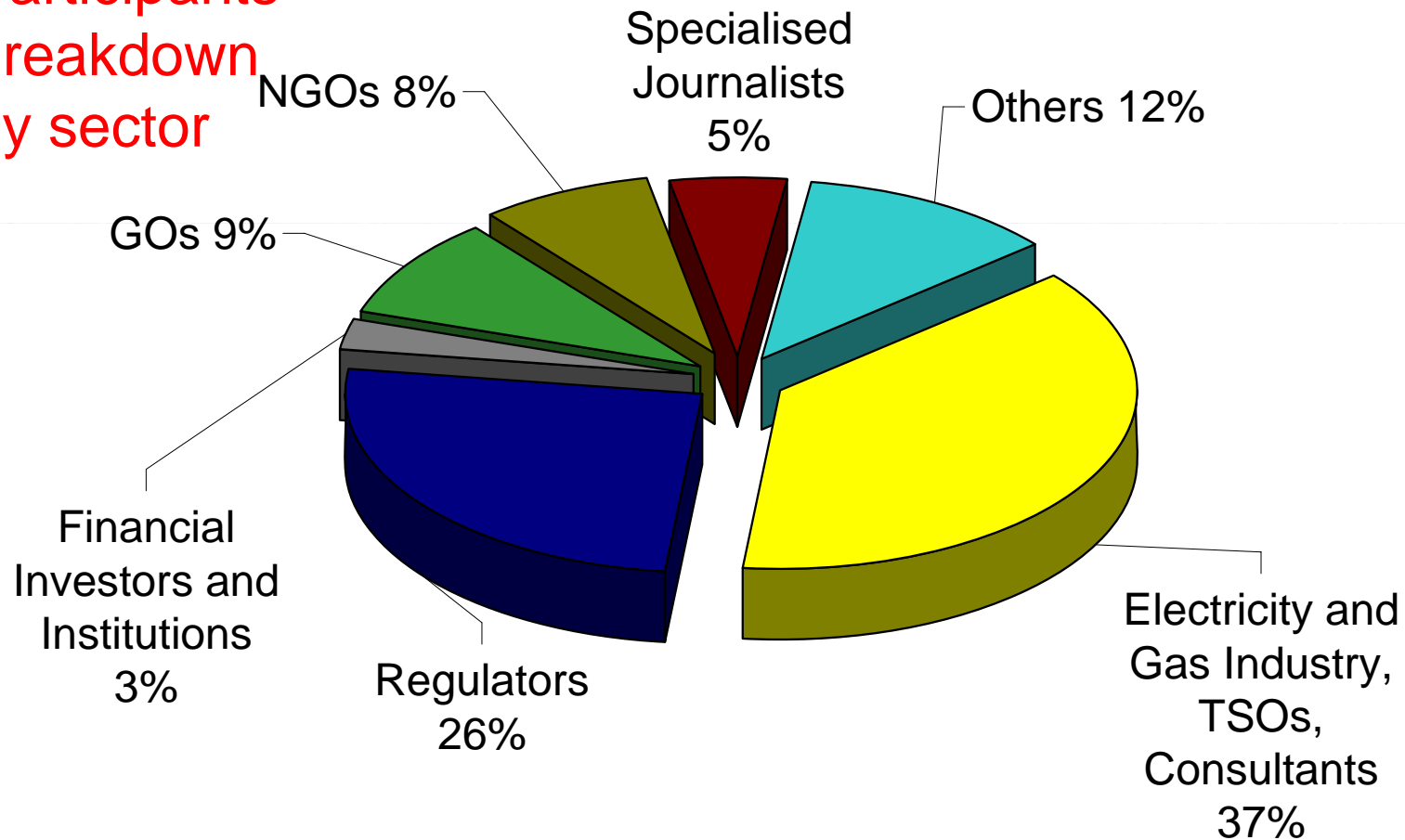
Participants

(ca. 940 participants)



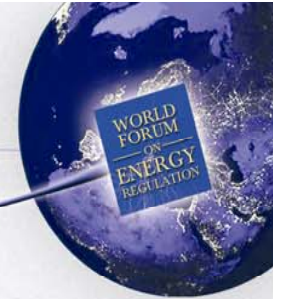
